1.6	Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2014, section 136A.101, subdivision 5a, is amended to

1.8	Subd. 5a. Assigned family responsibility. "Assigned family responsibility" means
1.9	the amount of a family's contribution to a student's cost of attendance, as determined by a
1.10	federal need analysis. For dependent students, the assigned family responsibility is $96_{\underline{89}}$
1.11	percent of the parental contribution. For independent students with dependents other than
1.12	a spouse, the assigned family responsibility is <u>86_79</u> percent of the student contribution.
1.13	For independent students without dependents other than a spouse, the assigned family
1.14	responsibility is $50 43$ percent of the student contribution.
1.15	Sec. 2. Minnesota Statutes 2014, section 136A.121, subdivision 5, is amended to read:
1.16	Subd. 5. Grant stipends. The grant stipend shall be based on a sharing of
1.17	responsibility for covering the recognized cost of attendance by the applicant, the
1.18	applicant's family, and the government. The amount of a financial stipend must not
1.19	exceed a grant applicant's recognized cost of attendance, as defined in subdivision 6, after
1.20	deducting the following:
1.21	(1) the assigned student responsibility of at least $50_{48.9}$ percent of the cost of
1.22	attending the institution of the applicant's choosing;
1.23	(2) the assigned family responsibility as defined in section 136A.101; and
