1.5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.6 Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2016, section 169.4503, subdivision 5, is amended to read:

1.7 Subd. 5. **Colors.** Fenderettes may be black. The beltline may be painted yellow over
1.8 black or black over yellow. The rub rails shall be black or yellow. The area around the lenses
1.9 of alternately flashing signal lamps extending outward from the edge of the lamp three
1.10 inches, plus or minus one-quarter inch, to the sides and top and at least one inch to the
1.11 bottom, shall be black. Visors or hoods, black in color, with a minimum of four inches may
1.12 be provided.
