1.9	(1) for residents over age 13 and under age 18, \$5;
1.10	(2) for residents age 18 or over and under age 65, \$23;
1.11	(3) for residents age 65 or over, \$11.50; and
1.12	(4) for nonresidents, \$84 \(\frac{\$200}{}\).
