1.6	Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2020, section 168.27, subdivision 31, is amended to read:
1.7	Subd. 31. <b>Documentary fee.</b> (a) A motor vehicle dealer may not charge a documentary
1.8	fee or document administration fee in excess of the amounts provided under paragraph (b)
1.9	for services actually rendered to, for, or on behalf of the retail buyer or lessee to prepare,
1.10	handle, and process documents for the closing of a motor vehicle retail sale or lease of a
1.11	vehicle being registered in the state of Minnesota. The fee must be separately stated on the
1.12	sales agreement maintained under Minnesota Rules, part 7400.5200, and may be excluded
1.13	from the dealer's advertised price.
1.14	(b) For motor vehicle sales or leases made on or after July 1, 2017 2022, through June
