1.8	Section 1. CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENT PROPOSED.
1.9	An amendment to the Minnesota Constitution is proposed to the people. If the amendment
1.10	is adopted, article XIV, section 13, will read:
1.11	Sec. 13. The revenue apportioned in section 12 must be allocated for the following
1.12	transportation purposes: not more less than 60 70 percent must be deposited in the highway
1.13	user tax distribution fund, and not less more than 40 30 percent must be deposited in a fund
