A bill for an act

relating to state government; appropriating money to the senate and house of representatives; requiring transfers.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

Section 1. **SENATE; APPROPRIATION.**

\$32,299,000 in fiscal year 2018 and \$32,105,000 in fiscal year 2019 are appropriated from the general fund to the senate.

Sec. 2. **HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES; APPROPRIATION.**

\$32,383,000 in fiscal year 2018 and \$32,383,000 in fiscal year 2019 are appropriated from the general fund to the house of representatives.

Sec. 3. **TRANSFERS REQUIRED.**

No later than June 30, 2018, the senate and house of representatives must transfer back to the Legislative Coordinating Commission all money transferred to the senate and house of representatives pursuant to resolution LCC-3, adopted by the Legislative Coordinating Commission on November 16, 2017.

Sec. 4. **EFFECTIVE DATE.**

This act is effective retroactively from July 1, 2017, and supersedes and replaces funding authorized by order of the Second Judicial District Court in Case No. 62-CV-17-3601.
