(a) Notwithstanding any other requirement of this 1.8 section, the commissioner may authorize long-term care insurance to be sold as part of or 1.9 in conjunction with life insurance, where that type of policy: 1.10 (1) is not permitted under current law; 1.11 (2) represents an innovative and reasonable approach to provide both life insurance and 1.12 long-term care insurance; 1.13 1.14 (3) provides reasonable coverage; and (4) is in the best interest of insureds. 1.15

(b) The insurer filing for authorization under this section must demonstrate that the
