2.5 Subd. 2. **Acts prohibited.** (a) Except as otherwise provided herein, whoever owns,  
2.6 possesses, or operates a machine gun, any trigger activator or machine gun conversion kit,  
2.7 or a short-barreled shotgun may be sentenced to imprisonment for not more than five years  
2.8 or to payment of a fine of not more than \$10,000, or both.

2.9 (b) Except as otherwise provided herein, it is unlawful to sell or transfer ownership of  
2.10 a bump stock.
