1.8	park permits for:
1.9	(1) a physically disabled person with a motor vehicle (i) that has disability plates issued
1.10	under section 168.021, subdivision 1, or (ii) who has a permanent disability certificate issued
1.11	under section 169.345 and who can demonstrate proof of ownership of the vehicle for which
1.12	the state park permit is being purchased or proof of a leasehold interest in the vehicle for a
1.13	term at least as long as the term of the permit;
1.14	(2) a physically disabled person who: (i) does not own or operate a motor vehicle; (ii)
1.15	possesses a statement certified under section 169.345, subdivision 2a; and (iii) applies to
1.16	the commissioner in writing; and
