1.7	Subd. 5. Disaster. "Disaster" means any catastrophe, including but not limited to a
1.8	tornado, storm, high water, wind-driven water, tidal wave, earthquake, volcanic eruption,
1.9	landslide, mudslide, snowstorm, or drought or, regardless of cause, any fire, flood, or
1.10	explosion. A disaster does not include a catastrophe caused by civil unrest.
1.11	<b>EFFECTIVE DATE.</b> This section is effective retroactively from January 1, 2020.
