1.1 A bill for an act

relating to human services; establishing grants for culturally competent supports

and resources related to well-being and long-term services and supports;

appropriating money.

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#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

### Section 1. APPROPRIATION; HEALTH AWARENESS HUB PILOT PROJECT.

\$575,000 in fiscal year 2025 is appropriated from the general fund to the commissioner of human services for a grant to the Organization for Liberians in Minnesota for a health awareness hub pilot project. The pilot project must seek to address health care education and the physical and mental wellness needs of elderly individuals within the African immigrant community by offering culturally relevant support, resources, and preventive care education from medical practitioners who have a similar background, and making appropriate referrals to culturally competent programs, supports, and medical care. Within six months of the conclusion of the pilot project, the Organization for Liberians in Minnesota must provide the commissioner with an evaluation of the project as determined by the commissioner. This is a onetime appropriation and is available until June 30, 2027.

## Sec. 2. APPROPRIATION; CHAPTER 245D COMPLIANCE SUPPORT GRANT.

\$450,000 in fiscal year 2025 is appropriated from the general fund to the commissioner of human services for a grant to Equitable Development Action to support minority providers licensed under Minnesota Statutes, chapter 245D, as intensive support services providers to build skills and the infrastructure needed to increase the quality of services provided to the people they serve while complying with the requirements of Minnesota Statutes, chapter
