BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

Section 1. ST. LOUIS RIVER ESTUARY AND DULUTH HARBOR CLEANUP.
- 1.6

Subdivision 1. **Appropriation.** \$25,400,000 is appropriated from the bond proceeds
- 1.7

fund to the Pollution Control Agency for removal of polluted riverbed sediment and industrial
- 1.8

waste from contaminated sites and other cleanup activities to restore water quality in the
- 1.9

St. Louis River estuary and Duluth harbor and bay.
- 1.10

Subd. 2. **Bond sale.** To provide the money appropriated in this section from the bond
- 1.11

proceeds fund, the commissioner of management and budget shall sell and issue bonds of
- 1.12

the state in an amount up to \$25,400,000 in the manner, upon the terms, and with the effect
- 1.13

prescribed by Minnesota Statutes, sections 16A.631 to 16A.675, and by the Minnesota

Constitution, article XI, sections 4 to 7.

EFFECTIVE DATE. This section is effective the day following final enactment.
