1.9	and recreation board in a city of the first class, or a federally recognized Indian Tribe. "Park
1.10	zone" includes the area within 300 feet or one city block, whichever distance is greater, of
1.11	the park boundary.
1.12	<b>EFFECTIVE DATE.</b> This section is effective August 1, 2022, and applies to crimes

committed on or after that date. 1.13
