Section	1. MINNESOTA FARMS AND PRODUCTS; HUMANITARIAN RELIEF
AID FO	R UKRAINE DEMOCRACY.
Subd	ivision 1. Appropriation. \$10,000,000 in fiscal year 2023 is appropriated from
the gener	ral fund to the commissioner of administration to purchase products produced or
grown in	Minnesota to be distributed as humanitarian aid as quickly as possible to the
democrat	tically elected president of Ukraine or to leaders of neighboring democratic countries
for the h	umanitarian benefit of the people of Ukraine. The commissioner of administration
must con	asult with the commissioner of employment and economic development and the
commiss	sioner of agriculture to identify products produced and grown in Minnesota. This
s a oneti	ime appropriation.
Subd	. 2. Gifts and grants. The commissioner of administration is authorized to accept
gifts and	grants to augment the state's humanitarian aid under subdivision 1.
Subd	. 3. Report. The commissioner of administration must report monthly to the chairs
and rank	ing minority members of the committee in the senate with jurisdiction over finance
and the c	committee in the house of representatives with jurisdiction over ways and means
on the us	e of the funds appropriated in subdivision 1 and the gifts and grants received under
subdivisi	ion 2.
