1.5	Subdivision 1. Department of Education. The sum indicated in this section is

1.8	Subd. 2. County law library grants. (a) For grants to individual county law libraries
1.9	to address revenue shortfalls in fiscal year 2020 and fiscal year 2021.

1.11	(b) To receive a grant under this section, a county law library must:
1.12	(1) have staff totaling at least one full-time equivalent employee;

1.15	(3) not raise their criminal filing fees under Minnesota Statutes, sections 134A.09 and
