.5	Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2012, section 13.82, is amended by adding a subdivision

.7	Subd. 31. License plate data. (a) For purposes of this subdivision, "automated
.8	license plate reader data" means government data derived from an automated reader that
.9	captures motor vehicle license plate numbers.
.10	(b) Automated license plate reader data are private data on individuals or nonpublic
.11	data. Notwithstanding section 138.17, automated license plate reader data must be
.12	destroyed within 24 hours of collection of the data, unless the data identify a vehicle or
.13	license plates that have been stolen, there is a warrant for the arrest of the owner of the
.14	vehicle or the owner has a suspended or revoked driver's license, or the data are active
.15	investigative data.
