1.5	Section 1. VIOLATION OF EXECUTIVE ORDERS AT CONCLUSION OF
1.6	PEACETIME EMERGENCY.
1.7	(a) Notwithstanding any other law to the contrary, a board or licensing agency that
1.8	suspended a license for a violation of Executive Order 20-04, as extended, amended, or
1.9	otherwise modified, and any related executive orders issued pursuant to Minnesota Statutes,
1.10	section 12.21 or 12.31, must immediately reinstate the license to good standing upon the
1.11	expiration of the peacetime emergency.
1.12	(b) Notwithstanding any other law to the contrary, a fine, civil penalty, or criminal
1.13	penalty imposed for violation of Executive Order 20-04, as extended, amended, or otherwise
1.14	modified, and any related executive orders issued pursuant to Minnesota Statutes, section
1.15	12.21 or 12.31, must be immediately forgiven without penalty upon the expiration of the
1.16	peacetime emergency.
1.17	<b>EFFECTIVE DATE.</b> This section is effective the day following final enactment.
