1.4 Section 1. LABOR AGREEMENT RATIFIED; MINNESOTA GOVERNMENT
1.5 ENGINEERING COUNCIL.

1.6 The arbitration award and labor agreement between the state of Minnesota and the
1.7 Minnesota Government Engineering Council, submitted to the Legislative Coordinating
1.8 Commission Subcommittee on Employee Relations on July 28, 2016, and implemented as
1.9 provided in Minnesota Statutes, section 3.855, subdivision 2, are ratified.

1.10 EFFECTIVE DATE. This section is effective retroactively from May 22, 2017.
