1.8	(a) The commissioner of health shall award grants to eligible nonprofit organizations
1.9	and counties for the purposes of maximizing resources to provide access to crisis services
1.10	across the state and educating communities on how to access local resources and suicide
1.11	lifelines.
1.12	(b) A grantee must use the grant funds to:
1.13	(1) provide a method of response that triages inquiries and provides immediate access
1.14	to suicide prevention and crisis counseling over the telephone;
1.15	(2) connect individuals with trained crisis counselors and local resources, including
1.16	referrals to community mental health options, emergency departments, and locally available
1.17	mobile crisis teams, when appropriate; or
1.18	(3) host an accredited suicide lifeline.
