6	Section 1. U.S. HIGHWAY 10 EXPANSION; APPROPRIATION AND TRUNK
7	HIGHWAY BOND SALE AUTHORIZATION.
	Subdivision 1. Appropriation. \$30,000,000 is appropriated from the bond proceeds
	account in the trunk highway fund to the commissioner of transportation to construct a third
	travel lane in each direction of marked U.S. Highway 10 from the interchange with Hanson
	Boulevard in the city of Coon Rapids to the interchange with 7th Avenue in the city of
	Anoka.
	Subd. 2. Bond sale. To provide the money appropriated in subdivision 1 from the bond
	proceeds account in the trunk highway fund, the commissioner of management and budget
	shall sell and issue bonds of the state in an amount up to \$30,000,000 in the manner, upon
	the terms, and with the effect prescribed by Minnesota Statutes, sections 167.50 to 167.52,
	and by the Minnesota Constitution, article XIV, section 11, at the times and in the amounts
	requested by the commissioner of transportation. The proceeds of the bonds, except accrued
	interest and any premium received from the sale of the bonds, must be deposited in the bond
	proceeds account in the trunk highway fund.
	<b>EFFECTIVE DATE.</b> This section is effective the day following final enactment.
