1.7	Subd. 4. Purpose of fund. (a) The purpose of this fund is to:
1.8	(1) compensate owners or lessees of residential real estate who meet the requirements
1.9	of this section;
1.10	(2) reimburse the department for all legal and administrative expenses, disbursements,
1.11	and costs, including staffing costs, incurred in administering and defending the fund;
1.12	(3) pay for educational or research projects in the field of residential contracting to
1.13	further the purposes of sections 326B.801 to 326B.825; and
1.14	(4) provide information to the public on residential contracting issues.
