1.4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:
1.5	Section 1. TITLE.
1.6	This act shall be known as the "Paid Youth Trades Employment Opportunity Act."
1.7	Sec. 2. 16- AND 17-YEAR-OLDS PERMITTED TO WORK IN OR AROUND
1.8	CONSTRUCTION OR BUILDING PROJECTS.
1.9	(a) Notwithstanding anything to the contrary, 16- and 17-year-olds may lawfully work
1.10	in or around a construction or building project.
1.11	(b) The commissioner of labor and industry must amend Minnesota Rules, part 5200.0910,
1.12	to remove the prohibition of employment of 16- and 17-year-olds in or around a construction
1.13	or building project under Minnesota Rules, part 5200.0910, item F. The commissioner must
1.14	also amend Minnesota Rules, part 5200.0920, to clarify that employment of individuals
1.15	under age 16 years in or around construction sites remains prohibited. The commissioner
1.16	may use the good cause exemption under Minnesota Statutes, section 14.388, subdivision
1.17	1, to amend Minnesota Rules, parts 5200.0910 and 5200.0920.
1.18	(c) Nothing in this section shall be construed to affect any existing law or rule regarding
1.19	work by 16- and 17-year-olds other than the general prohibition under Minnesota Rules,
