- (a) The commissioner of the Pollution Control Agency or a county board shall not approve any permits for the construction of new open-air swine basins, except that existing facilities may use one basin of less than 1,000,000 gallons as part of a permitted waste treatment program for resolving pollution problems or to allow conversion of an existing 1.10 basin of less than 1,000,000 gallons to a different animal type, provided all standards are 1.11 met. This section expires June 30, 2022. 1.12
- (b) This section does not apply to basins used solely for wastewater from truck-washing 1.13 facilities. 1.14
