\$225,000 in fiscal year 2020 is appropriated from the general fund to the commissioner of employment and economic development for a grant to WomenVenture to provide business training, mentoring, technical assistance, and loans in order to establish two pilot women-run cooperative child care businesses in low-income areas. The commissioner shall report data on outcomes and recommendations for replication of this pilot program throughout Minnesota to the governor and the legislative committees with jurisdiction over child care by January 31, 2022. This is a onetime appropriation and funds are available until June 30, 2021.
