BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:
Section 1. HOMELESS ENCAMPMENT ASSISTANCE AND NAVIGATION
CENTERS.
\$ in fiscal year 2021 is appropriated from the general fund to the commissioner of
human services to work in coordination with the commissioner of the Housing Finance
Agency, along with cities and counties where homeless encampments are located, to create
navigation centers to provide temporary housing, health care, sanitation, and services to
assist individuals living in homeless encampments. The commissioner of human services
may spend the appropriation only on navigation centers established in cities of the first
<u>class.</u>
Notwithstanding any local government zoning or nuisance laws, the commissioner of
human services, the commissioner of the Housing Finance Agency, and the local governments
where homeless encampments are located must create navigation centers that provide:
(1) temporary housing, including but not limited to accessory dwelling units, enclosed
trailers, manufactured homes, and hotels to shelter persons currently living in homeless
encampments;
(2) 24-hour staffing and sanitation services to the temporary housing provided by a
navigation center;
(3) assistance to individuals seeking assistance from a navigation center; and
