1.5 Section 1. **SUMMARY OF APPROPRIATIONS.**

 1.7 the general fund to the agencies and for the purposes specified in this act, to be available
 1.8 for the fiscal year indicated for each purpose, and are added to appropriations in Laws
 1.9 2007, chapters 54 and 147. The figure "2009," where used in this act, means that the
 1.10 appropriation or appropriations listed under it are available for the year ending June 30,
 1.11 2009.
