

1.1 A bill for an act

1.2 relating to metropolitan government; authorizing annual audit of Metropolitan
1.3 Council by private certified public accountants; amending Minnesota Statutes
1.4 2008, section 473.13, subdivision 4.

1.5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.6 Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2008, section 473.13, subdivision 4, is amended to read:

1.7 Subd. 4. **Accounts; audits.** The council shall keep an accurate account of its
1.8 receipts and disbursements. Disbursements of council money must be made by check
1.9 or by electronic funds transfer, signed or authorized by the chair or vice-chair of the
1.10 council, and countersigned or authorized by its regional administrator or designee after
1.11 whatever auditing and approval of the expenditure may be required by the council. The
1.12 ~~state auditor~~ council shall provide for an annual audit of the books and accounts of the
1.13 ~~council once each year, or as often as funds and personnel of the state auditor permit by~~
1.14 the state auditor or a private certified public accountant in accordance with minimum
1.15 procedures prescribed by the state auditor. If the audit is performed by the state auditor,
1.16 the council shall pay to the state the total cost and expenses of the examination, including
1.17 the salaries paid to the auditors while actually engaged in making the examination. The
1.18 general fund must be credited with all collections made for any examination by the
1.19 state auditor. If the audit is performed by a private certified public accountant, the state
1.20 auditor may require additional information from the private certified public accountant
1.21 as the state auditor deems in the public interest. The state auditor may accept the audit
1.22 or make additional examinations as the state auditor deems to be in the public interest.
