1.2 relating to transportation; designating the Richard J. Ames Memorial Highway;

1.3 amending Minnesota Statutes 2018, section 161.14, by adding a subdivision.

1.4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.5 Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2018, section 161.14, is amended by adding a subdivision

1.6 to read:

1.7 Subd. 88. Richard J. Ames Memorial Highway. (a) The following route between the

1.8 city of Jordan and marked U.S. Highway 61 shall be known as the "Richard J. Ames

1.9 Memorial Highway":

1.10 Beginning at a point at the eastern city limits of Jordan; thence extending easterly along

1.11 marked Trunk Highway 282 to its junction with marked Trunk Highway 13; thence extending

1.12 northerly along marked Trunk Highway 13 to its junction with Eagle Creek Avenue in the

1.13 city limits of Prior Lake; thence extending easterly along Eagle Creek Avenue and 185th

1.14 Street East to its junction with Kenwood Trail and Dakota County State-Aid Highway 50;

1.15 thence extending easterly and southerly along Kenwood Trail and Dakota County State-Aid

1.16 Highway 50 to its junction with marked Trunk Highway 3 in the city limits of Farmington;

1.17 thence extending southerly along marked Trunk Highway 3 to its junction with marked

1.18 Trunk Highway 50; thence extending easterly along marked Trunk Highway 50 to its

1.19 terminus at its junction with marked Trunk Highway 20 and marked U.S. Highway 61 near

1.20 Miesville.

1.21 (b) Subject to section 161.139, the commissioner shall adopt a suitable design to mark

1.22 this highway and erect appropriate signs, with the cost of the signs to be paid by the Ames

1.23 family.

2.1 **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective the day following final enactment.
