- 1.1 A bill for an act
- 1.2 relating to Minnesota State High School League; modifying the governing board
- 1.3 membership; amending Minnesota Statutes 2022, section 128C.01, subdivision 4.
- 1.4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:
- 1.5 Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2022, section 128C.01, subdivision 4, is amended to read:
- 1.6 Subd. 4. **Board.** (a) The league must have a ~~20~~ 22-member governing board.
- 1.7 (1) The governor must appoint four members according to section 15.0597. Each of the
- 1.8 four appointees must be a parent. At least one of them must be an American Indian, an
- 1.9 Asian, a Black, or a Hispanic.
- 1.10 (2) The Minnesota Association of Secondary School Principals must appoint two of its
- 1.11 members.
- 1.12 (3) The remaining ~~14~~ 16 members must be selected according to ~~league bylaws~~ the
- 1.13 league's constitution.
- 1.14 (b) The terms, compensation, removal of members, and the filling of membership
- 1.15 vacancies are governed by section 15.0575, except that the four-year terms begin on August
- 1.16 1 and end on July 31. As provided by section 15.0575, members who are full-time state
- 1.17 employees or full-time employees of school districts or other political subdivisions of the
- 1.18 state may not receive any per diem payment for service on the board.
