WHEREAS, the Prisoner of War - Missing in Action (POW/MIA) issue has been a national 1.4 dilemma since the end of World War II; and 1.5 WHEREAS, it is the responsibility and the duty of the United States government to bring 1.6 home Americans missing in action from the Vietnam War, the Cold War conflicts, the Korean War, 1.7 World War II, and other conflicts; and 1.8 WHEREAS, as of January 2021, the Government Accountability Office listed 79,764 service 1.9 men and women unaccounted for from World War II, the Korean War, Cold War conflicts, the 1.10 Vietnam War, the Gulf War, and other conflicts; and 1.11 WHEREAS, American Prisoners of War and their missing comrades have demonstrated the 1.12 true spirit of our nation and should never be forgotten; and 1.13 1.14 WHEREAS, Americans from every generation have answered the call to duty with dedication 1.15 and valor.
