BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2022, section 473.408, is amended by adding a subdivision

to read:

Subd. 4a. Transit passes. The council may establish transit fare programs and passes

that are consistent with the fare policy purposes stated in subdivision 2, including but not

limited to:

(1) discount pass programs for public and private employers, public and private

organizations, and school districts; and

(2) special pass programs for demonstration projects or special events.

Sec. 2. REPEALER.

Minnesota Statutes 2022, section 473.408, subdivisions 6, 7, 8, and 9, are repealed.

Sec. 3. EFFECTIVE DATE; APPLICATION.

This act is effective the day following final enactment and applies in the counties of

Anoka, Carver, Dakota, Hennepin, Ramsey, Scott, and Washington.
