Replacement is not required where 2.21 it would be contrary to public safety or when sparsity of population, other available ways 2.22 or other factors indicate an absence of need for such facility or access. When the road 2.23 authority is the commissioner, the commissioner must not convert vehicle travel lanes on 2.24 the trunk highway system into a bicycle lane or bicycle route. 2.25
