1.5	Section 1. APPROPRIATION; COUNTY AGRICULTURAL SOCIETY
1.6	GRANTS.
1.7	(a) \$3,785,000 in fiscal year 2012 and \$3,785,000 in fiscal year 2013 are appropriated
1.8	from the arts and cultural heritage fund to the commissioner of agriculture for grants to
1.9	county agricultural societies to enhance arts access and education, and to preserve and
1.10	promote Minnesota's history and cultural heritage as embodied in its county fairs. The
1.11	grants shall be in addition to the aid distribution to county agricultural societies under
1.12	Minnesota Statutes, section 38.02. The commissioner shall award grants for the following
1.13	purposes:
1.14	(1) \$950,000 in each year, distributed in equal amounts to each of the 95 county
1.15	fairs, to enhance arts access and education, and to preserve and promote Minnesota's

1.18	enhancement of facilities that provide access to the arts; arts education; and agricultural,

1.22	events that provide access to the arts or the state's agricultural, historical, and cultural
