



**S.F. No. 1254, as introduced - 87th Legislative Session (2011-2012) [11-3060]**

2.1 construction, alteration, or repair, or in a conspicuous place within the area being  
2.2 protected. If the area being protected is less than three acres, one additional sign must be  
2.3 conspicuously placed within that area. If the area being protected is three acres but less  
2.4 than ten acres, two additional signs must be conspicuously placed within that area. For  
2.5 each additional full ten acres of area being protected beyond the first ten acres of area, two  
2.6 additional signs must be conspicuously placed within the area being protected. The sign  
2.7 must carry a general notice warning against trespass; and

2.8 (iii) in paragraph (b), clause (10), means the placement of signs that:

2.9 (A) carry a general notice warning against trespass;

2.10 (B) display letters at least two inches high;

2.11 (C) state that Minnesota law prohibits trespassing on the property; and

2.12 (D) are posted in a conspicuous place and at intervals of 500 feet or less.

2.13 (6) "Business licensee," as used in paragraph (b), clause (9), includes a representative  
2.14 of a building trades labor or management organization.

2.15 (7) "Building" has the meaning given in section 609.581, subdivision 2.

2.16 (b) A person is guilty of a misdemeanor if the person intentionally:

2.17 (1) permits domestic animals or fowls under the actor's control to go on the land  
2.18 of another within a city;

2.19 (2) interferes unlawfully with a monument, sign, or pointer erected or marked to  
2.20 designate a point of a boundary, line or a political subdivision, or of a tract of land;

2.21 (3) trespasses on the premises of another and, without claim of right, refuses to  
2.22 depart from the premises on demand of the lawful possessor;

2.23 (4) occupies or enters the dwelling or locked or posted building of another, without  
2.24 claim of right or consent of the owner or the consent of one who has the right to give  
2.25 consent, except in an emergency situation;

2.26 (5) enters the premises of another with intent to take or injure any fruit, fruit trees, or  
2.27 vegetables growing on the premises, without the permission of the owner or occupant;

2.28 (6) enters or is found on the premises of a public or private cemetery without  
2.29 authorization during hours the cemetery is posted as closed to the public;

2.30 (7) returns to the property of another with the intent to abuse, disturb, or cause  
2.31 distress in or threaten another, after being told to leave the property and not to return, if the  
2.32 actor is without claim of right to the property or consent of one with authority to consent;

2.33 (8) returns to the property of another within one year after being told to leave the  
2.34 property and not to return, if the actor is without claim of right to the property or consent  
2.35 of one with authority to consent;

3.1 (9) enters the locked or posted construction site of another without the consent of the  
3.2 owner or lawful possessor, unless the person is a business licensee;

3.3 (10) enters the locked or posted aggregate mining site of another without the consent  
3.4 of the owner or lawful possessor, unless the person is a business licensee; ~~or~~

3.5 (11) crosses into or enters any public or private area lawfully cordoned off by or at  
3.6 the direction of a peace officer engaged in the performance of official duties. As used in  
3.7 this clause: (i) an area may be "cordoned off" through the use of tape, barriers, or other  
3.8 means conspicuously placed and identifying the area as being restricted by a peace officer  
3.9 and identifying the responsible authority; and (ii) "peace officer" has the meaning given in  
3.10 section 626.84, subdivision 1. It is an affirmative defense to a charge under this clause that  
3.11 a peace officer permitted entry into the restricted area; or

3.12 (12) enters the premises of another after being notified in writing that entry by the  
3.13 specific actor is prohibited, if the actor is without claim of right to the property or consent  
3.14 of one with authority to consent.

3.15 **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective August 1, 2011, and applies to crimes  
3.16 committed on or after that date.
