1.1A bill for an act

1.2relating to human services; establishing the Taylor Hayden Gun Violence

1.3Prevention Act; appropriating money.

1.4BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.5Section 1. **TAYLOR HAYDEN GUN VIOLENCE PREVENTION ACT.**

1.6This act may be cited as the "Taylor Hayden Gun Violence Prevention Act." To reduce

1.7the number of injuries and deaths of innocent individuals in the community and to increase

1.8community safety, the commissioner of human services shall develop a competitive bidding

1.9process to award grants to nonprofit organizations with expertise in gun violence prevention.

1.10A nonprofit organization awarded a grant must use the money for gun violence prevention

1.11or public awareness and education campaigns on gun violence prevention.

1.12Sec. 2. **APPROPRIATION.**

1.13\$200,000 in fiscal year 2018 and \$200,000 in fiscal year 2019 are appropriated from the

1.14general fund to the commissioner of human services to provide grants described in section

1.151.
