- 1.2 relating to state lands; authorizing public sale of certain tax-forfeited land that
- 1.3 borders public water.
- 1.4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:
- 1.5 Section 1. **PUBLIC SALE OF TAX-FORFEITED LANDS BORDERING PUBLIC**
- 1.6 **WATER; POLK COUNTY.**
- 1.7 (a) Notwithstanding Minnesota Statutes, sections 92.45 and 282.018, subdivision 1, Polk
- 1.8 County may sell the tax-forfeited lands bordering public water that are described in paragraph
- 1.9 (c) under the remaining provisions of Minnesota Statutes, chapter 282.
- 1.10 (b) The conveyances must be in a form approved by the attorney general. The attorney
- 1.11 general may make changes to the land descriptions to correct errors and ensure accuracy.
- 1.12 (c) The land to be sold is located in Polk County and is described as:
- 1.13 (1) Lots 1, 2, 3, and 4, subject to railway easement, Block 54, Carman Townsite, city
- 1.14 of Crookston (parcel number 82.02352.00);
- 1.15 (2) Lots 5 and 6, Block 54, Carman Townsite, city of Crookston (parcel number
- 1.16 82.02352.01);
- 1.17 (3) the North 7.30 acres of the East 13.60 acres of Lot 3, Section 26, Township 150,
- 1.18 Range 48 (parcel number 24.00170.00);
- 1.19 (4) Lot 5, Block 2, Northern Lights Addition, city of Erskine (parcel number
- 1.20 45.00504.00); and

- 2.1 (5) part of Government Lot 9, Section 36, Township 150, Range 47 (parcel number
2.2 82.00129.00).
- 2.3 (d) The county has determined that the county's land management interests would best
2.4 be served if the lands were returned to private ownership.
