BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA: 1.3 Section 1. SCHOOL SAFETY GRANTS; APPROPRIATION. 1.4 (a) \$250,000,000 in fiscal year 2020 and \$250,000,000 in fiscal year 2021 are 1.5 appropriated from the general fund to the commissioner of education for school safety 1.6 facility grants for improvements related to violence prevention and facility security. 1.7 (b) A school district may apply for a school safety facility grant in the form and manner 1.8 specified by the commissioner of education. 1.9 (c) After consultation with the Department of Public Safety's Minnesota School Safety 1.10 Center, the commissioner of education may award a school safety facility grant to a school 1.11 district of no more than \$500,000 for each qualifying school building.
