- 1.1 A bill for an act
- 1.2 relating to commerce; weights and measures; requiring signage disclosing gasoline
- 1.3 tax rate; proposing coding for new law in Minnesota Statutes, chapter 239.
- 1.4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:
- 1.5 Section 1. **[239.7511] GAS TAX SIGN ON PETROLEUM DISPENSER.**
- 1.6 (a) The director must ensure that signs having 12-point font or greater are affixed on
- 1.7 retail petroleum dispensers as follows:
- 1.8 (1) for regular or premium gasoline, a sign that reads: "The price for each gallon of
- 1.9 gasoline includes the current state and federal gasoline taxes totaling 46.9 cents per gallon.";
- 1.10 and
- 1.11 (2) for diesel fuel, a sign that reads: "The price for each gallon of diesel fuel includes
- 1.12 the current state and federal gasoline taxes totaling 52.9 cents per gallon."
- 1.13 (b) The director must distribute the signs under this section to the owner or operator of
- 1.14 retail petroleum dispensers. To the extent possible, the director must coordinate the
- 1.15 distribution of signs with other duties the director may have involving retail petroleum
- 1.16 dispensers.
- 1.17 (c) If the amount of the gasoline tax described in paragraph (a), clauses (1) and (2),
- 1.18 changes, the director must distribute revised signs to reflect the updated gasoline tax amounts
- 1.19 within 12 calendar months of the change.
- 1.20 (d) The director is prohibited from assessing any penalty, fine, or fee on the owner or
- 1.21 operator of a retail petroleum dispenser that has a missing, destroyed, defaced, or otherwise
- 1.22 damaged gas tax sign.
