1.5	Section 1. APPROPRIATION; CHILDREN'S SCHOOL-LINKED MENTAL

1.7	\$ in fiscal year 2018 and \$ in fiscal year 2019 are appropriated from the general
1.8	fund to the commissioner of human services for children's school-linked mental health
1.9	grants under Minnesota Statutes, section 245.4889, subdivision 1, paragraph (b), clause (8),
1.10	to expand services to school districts or counties in which school-linked mental health
1.11	services are not available, and to fund transportation for children using school-linked mental
