1.2relating to capital improvements; appropriating money to design and construct

1.3a regional transit facility in Mankato; authorizing the sale and issuance of state

1.5BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.6Section 1. **MANKATO REGIONAL TRANSIT FACILITY.**

1.7\$5,200,000 is appropriated from the bond proceeds fund to the commissioner

1.8of transportation for a grant to the city of Mankato to design, renovate, and equip the

1.9Minnesota Department of Transportation's former district 7 building in the city of Mankato

1.10as a regional transit facility. This renovation may include vehicle storage facilities, a

1.11fueling island, a bus wash facility, and remodeled and expanded maintenance facilities

1.12to accommodate the mechanics and equipment necessary to maintain city buses. An

1.13employee locker room and break area, along with office space with a central waiting area

1.14for intracity and intercity transit passengers, may also be included. In addition, the facility

1.15will be used in partnership with intracity and intercity providers as a multimodal hub. The

1.16facility may be designed for a regional bus rapid transit system providing service to the

1.17counties of Blue Earth, LeSueur, Nicollet, and Waseca.

1.18This appropriation is not available until the commissioner has determined that at least

1.19\$1,300,000 has been committed from nonstate sources.

1.20Sec. 2. **BOND SALE.**

1.21To provide the money appropriated in this act from the bond proceeds fund, the

1.22commissioner of management and budget shall sell and issue bonds of the state in an

1.23amount up to \$5,200,000 in the manner, upon the terms, and with the effect prescribed by
