1.2relating to state government; providing an exemption from E-Verify

1.3requirements; amending Minnesota Statutes 2014, section 16C.075.

1.4BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.5Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2014, section 16C.075, is amended to read:

1.616C.075 E-VERIFY.

1.7A contract for services valued in excess of \$50,000 must require certification from

1.8the vendor and any subcontractors that, as of the date services on behalf of the state of

1.9Minnesota will be performed, the vendor and all subcontractors have implemented or are

1.10in the process of implementing the federal E-Verify program for all newly hired employees

1.11in the United States who will perform work on behalf of the state of Minnesota. This

1.12section does not apply to contracts entered into by the:

- 1.13(1) State Board of Investment; and
- 1.14(2) the Office of Higher Education for contracts related to its loan and loan
- 1.15refinancing programs.

1.16EFFECTIVE DATE. This section is effective the day following final enactment.
