BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:
Section 1. APPROPRIATION.
\$2,000,000 is appropriated from the bond proceeds fund to the commissioner
of human services for a grant to the city of Maplewood to design, renovate, and equip
Harriet Tubman Center East to be used as a regional safety service center for domestic
violence shelter, legal services, youth programs, mental and chemical health services,
and community education.
Sec. 2. BOND SALE.
To provide the money appropriated in section 1 from the bond proceeds fund, the
commissioner of management and budget shall sell and issue bonds of the state in an
amount up to \$2,000,000 in the manner, upon the terms, and with the effect prescribed by
