- 1.1 A bill for an act
- 1.2 relating to transportation; establishing Minnesota 100 Club special plates;
- 1.3 appropriating money; proposing coding for new law in Minnesota Statutes, chapter
- 1.4 168.
- 1.5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:
- 1.6 Section 1. **[168.1258] MINNESOTA 100 CLUB PLATES.**
- 1.7 Subdivision 1. **Issuance of plates.** The commissioner must issue Minnesota 100 Club
- 1.8 special plates or a single motorcycle plate to an applicant who:
- 1.9 (1) is a registered owner of a passenger automobile, noncommercial one-ton pickup
- 1.10 truck, motorcycle, or recreational motor vehicle;
- 1.11 (2) pays the registration tax as required under section 168.013;
- 1.12 (3) pays a fee in the amount specified under section 168.12, subdivision 5, for each set
- 1.13 of plates, along with any other fees required by this chapter;
- 1.14 (4) contributes a minimum of \$..... annually to the Minnesota 100 Club account; and
- 1.15 (5) complies with this chapter and rules governing registration of motor vehicles and
- 1.16 licensing of drivers.
- 1.17 Subd. 2. **Design.** The commissioner must adopt a suitable design for the plate, in
- 1.18 consultation with representatives from the Minnesota 100 Club.
- 1.19 Subd. 3. **Plates transfer.** On application to the commissioner and payment of a transfer
- 1.20 fee of \$5, special plates issued under this section may be transferred to another motor vehicle
- 1.21 if the subsequent vehicle is:

- 2.1 (1) qualified under subdivision 1, clause (1), to bear the special plates; and
- 2.2 (2) registered to the same individual to whom the special plates were originally issued.
- 2.3 Subd. 4. **Exemption.** Special plates issued under this section are not subject to section
- 2.4 168.1293, subdivision 2.
- 2.5 Subd. 5. **Contributions; account; appropriation.** Contributions collected under
- 2.6 subdivision 1, clause (4), must be deposited in the Minnesota 100 Club account, which is
- 2.7 established in the special revenue fund. Money in the account is annually appropriated to
- 2.8 the commissioner. This appropriation is first for the annual cost of administering the account
- 2.9 funds, and the remaining funds are for distribution to the Minnesota 100 Club to further the
- 2.10 organization's mission and purpose of providing charitable gifts and contributions.
- 2.11 **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective July 1, 2021, for Minnesota 100 Club
- 2.12 special plates issued on or after that date.
