1.1A bill for an act

1.2relating to game and fish; expanding use of crossbows during firearms deer season;

1.3amending Minnesota Statutes 2020, section 97B.036.

1.4BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.5Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2020, section 97B.036, is amended to read:

1.697B.036 CROSSBOW HUNTING DURING FIREARMS SEASON.

1.7Notwithstanding section 97B.035, subdivisions 1 and 2, a person may take deer, bear,

1.8or turkey by crossbow during the respective regular firearms seasons. The transportation

1.9requirements of section 97B.051 apply to crossbows during the regular firearms deer, bear,

1.10or turkey season. Crossbows must meet the requirements of section 97B.106, subdivision

1.112. A person taking deer, bear, or turkey by crossbow under this section must have a valid

1.12firearms license to take the respective game or, when taking deer, a license to take deer by

1.13archery.
