(b) "Agricultural products" means any livestock, aquaculture, poultry, horticultural, 18 floricultural, viticultural, silvicultural, or other products of a farm or ranch. 19 (c) "Agritourism activity" means any activity carried out on a farm or ranch that 1 10 allows organizations or members of the general public, for recreational, entertainment, 1 11 charitable, or educational purposes, to view, enjoy, or participate in rural activities, 1.12 including farming; viticulture; winemaking; ranching; and historical, cultural, farm 1.13 stay, gleaning, harvest-your-own, or natural activities and attractions. An activity is an 1 14 agritourism activity whether or not the participant pays to participate in the activity. 1.15 (d) "Agritourism professional" means any person who is engaged in the business of 1.16 providing one or more agritourism activities, whether or not for compensation. 1 17 (e) "Farm or ranch" means one or more areas of land used for the production, 1 18 cultivation, growing, harvesting, or processing of agricultural products. 1.19 (f) "Farm stay" means to stay on a farm or ranch as a paying guest in order to 1.20 experience farm, ranch, or rural life. 1.21 (g) "Inherent risks of agritourism activity" mean dangers or conditions that are an 1.22 integral part of an agritourism activity including but not limited to: 1.23

3.10	EFFECTIVE DATE. This section is effective the day following final enactment

3.11 and applies to actions arising from injury, damage, or death occurring on or after that date.
