1.9	Subdivision 1. Number, term, pay. (a) The board of education of such district shall
1.10	consist of seven directors six members elected by district and three members elected
1.11	at large. The term of office of each director shall be four years or until a successor is
1.12	elected and qualified. The directors shall receive such compensation as may be fixed by
1.13	the board of education.
1.14	(b) The governing body of Special School District No. 1 may provide for election
1.15	of four of its directors in 1994 and subsequent years for four-year terms, and election of

128D.14 BOARD MEMBER REMOVAL LAW DOES NOT APPLY.

The provisions of section 123B.09, subdivision 9, concerning the removal of a board member or officer of an independent school district, shall not be applicable to the special independent school district of Minneapolis, established under the provisions of this chapter.
