1.5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.6 Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2022, section 216B.243, subdivision 3b, is amended to read:

1.7 Subd. 3b. ~~Nuclear power plant; new construction prohibited; relicensing~~ **Additional**

1.8 **storage of spent nuclear fuel.** ~~(a) The commission may not issue a certificate of need for~~

1.9 ~~the construction of a new nuclear-powered electric generating plant.~~

1.10 ~~(b)~~ Any certificate of need for additional storage of spent nuclear fuel for a facility

1.11 seeking a license extension shall address the impacts of continued operations over the period

1.12 for which approval is sought.
