## 1.6 Section 1. <u>NATURAL RESOURCES; MINNESOTA BIOMES.</u>

1.7 <u>Subdivision 1.</u> Appropriation. <u>\$4,000,000 is appropriated from the bond proceeds</u>

- 1.8 fund to the commissioner of natural resources to design and construct outdoor classroom
- 1.9 space and landscapes representing Minnesota biomes at the new James Ford Bell Museum
- 1.10 of Natural History on the St. Paul campus of the University of Minnesota.

### 1.11 Subd. 2. Bond sale. To provide the money appropriated in this section from the

- 1.12 bond proceeds fund, the commissioner of management and budget shall sell and issue
- 1.13 bonds of the state in an amount up to \$4,000,000 in the manner, upon the terms, and with
- 1.14 the effect prescribed by Minnesota Statutes, sections 16A.631 to 16A.675, and by the
- 1.15 Minnesota Constitution, article XI, sections 4 to 7.
