1.5	Section 1. APPROPRIATION; HOMEOWNERSHIP PROGRAM FOR
1.6	FAMILIES WITH CHILDREN WITH DISABILITIES.
1.7	(a) \$1,200,000 from the general fund is appropriated to the Minnesota Housing
1.8	Finance Agency for fiscal year 2015 for a pilot program for families with children with
1.9	disabilities to provide grants for homeownership. Eligible families must: (1) have one
1.10	child under the age of 19 with a medically diagnosed disability, and (2) have faced housing
1.11	instability as renters due to the child's disability in the last two years requiring them to
