Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2013 Supplement, section 340A.402, is amended by

Subd. 1a. **Off-sale licenses; Minnesota residents.** (a) A license for the off-sale of

intoxicating liquor may only be issued to a person who is a Minnesota resident.

(b) This subdivision shall not apply to any person who holds a license for off-sale

1.11

of intoxicating liquor as of June 30, 2014.
